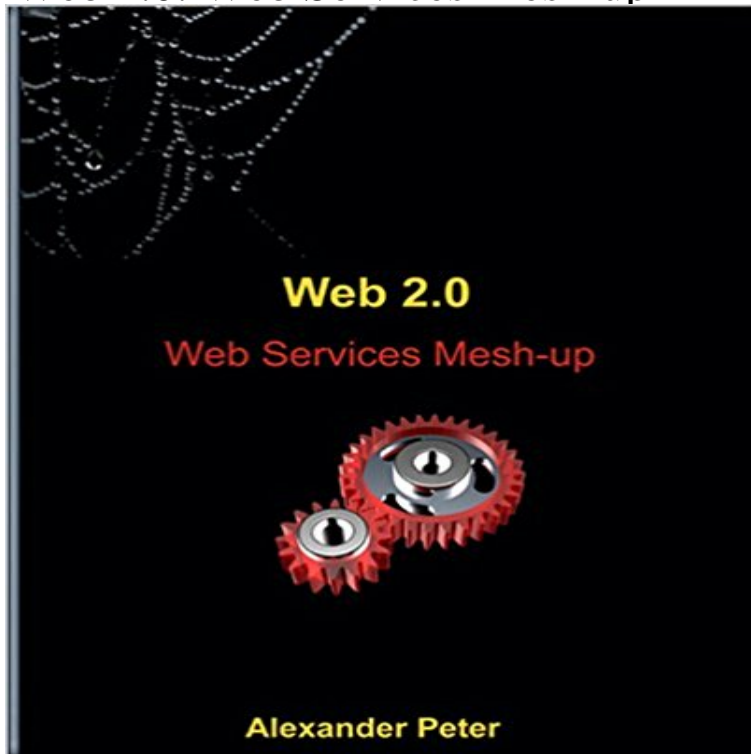


Web 2.0: Web Services Mesh-up

Similar to music mash-ups, a Web application mash-up combines complementary functionality from multiple Web sites or Web applications, e.g., combining Google Maps with Craigslist apartment listings so that you can find all apartments for rent in a particular neighborhood. Developers have created mash-ups using Web services and RSS/ATOM feeds from several popular Web sites including Google, Microsoft, Yahoo!, Flickr and many others.
