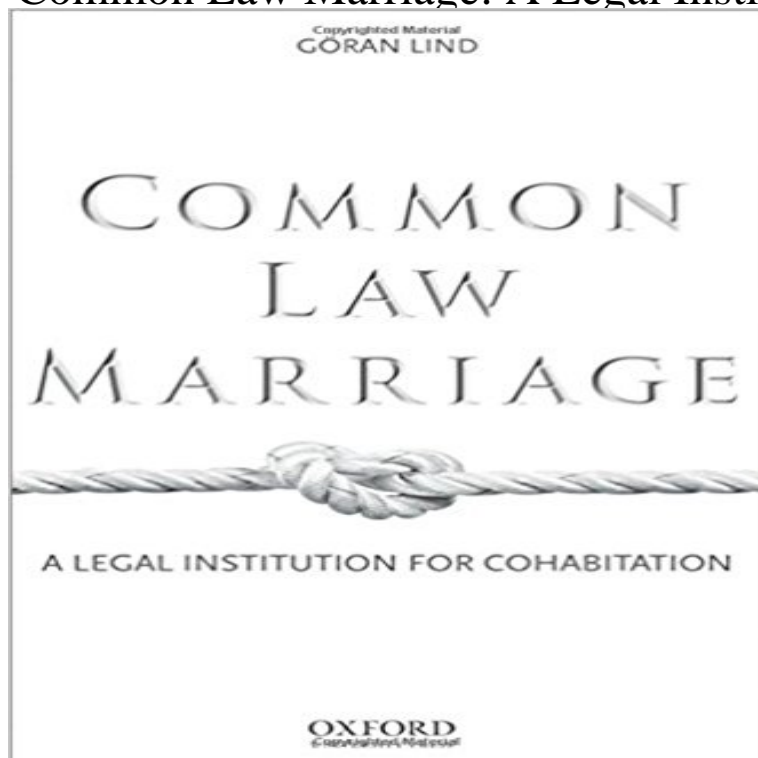


Common Law Marriage: A Legal Institution for Cohabitation
