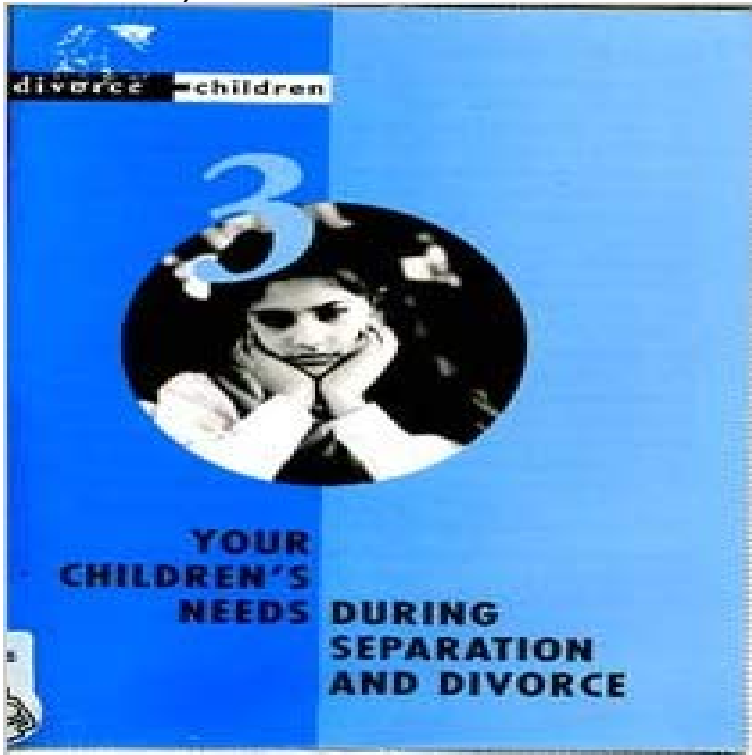


Your Childrens Needs During Separation and Divorce (Divorce & Children)
