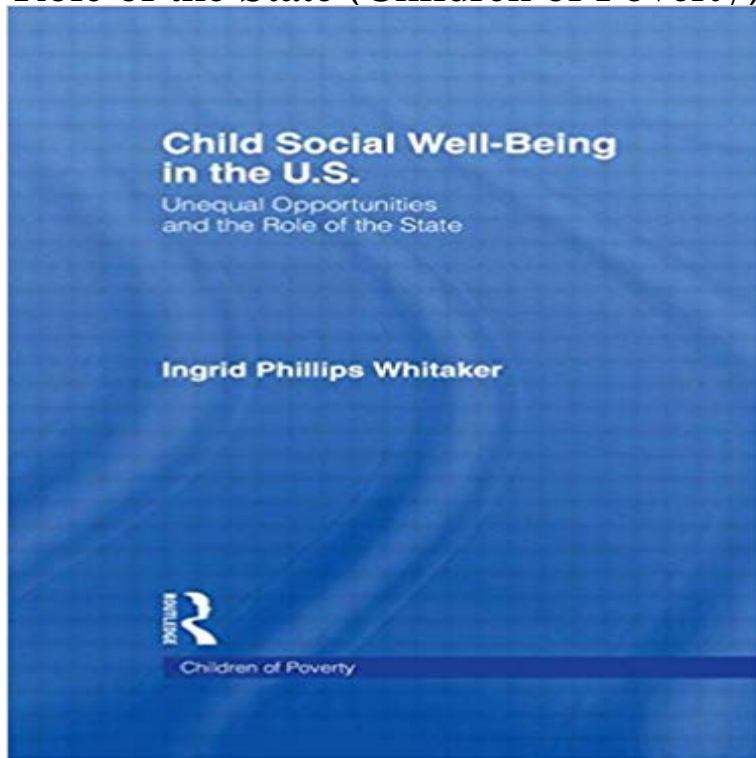


# Child Social Well-Being in the U.S. : Unequal Opportunities and the Role of the State (Children of Poverty)
