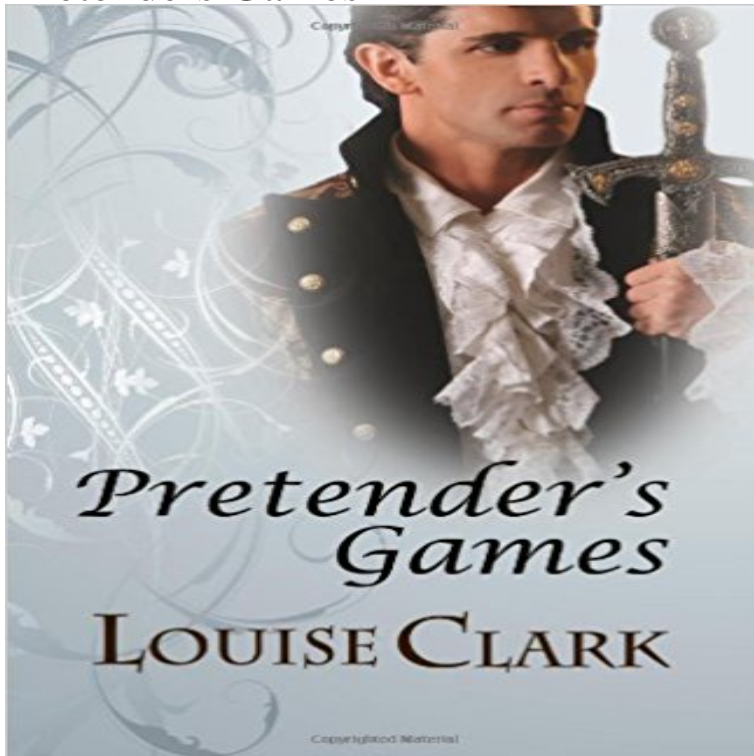


Pretenders Games



Through a story of exile and homecoming, of two cultures brought together but not yet at peace, Louise Clark brings forth a thoroughly entertaining romance. Romantic Times Reviews, 4 stars Scotland, 1745 Bonnie Prince Charlie, the glamorous and charming Stuart pretender to the throne of Great Britain, raises the Highlands of Scotland in rebellion. Among his followers is James MacLonan, a young, idealistic believer in the Jacobite cause. The Pretenders rebellion blazes a path across Scotland, but in April 1746 the Stuart army is slaughtered at the Battle of Culloden. James flees to France, fearing he will never be allowed to return to Scotland. Edinburgh, 1750 Four years have passed. James is offered a pardon, but the terms require him to marry a woman with ties to the English king. If he does not he will be exiled forever. Theadora Tilton is the daughter of the English general. She is deeply attracted to James MacLonan, but he is a Jacobite rebel and she has always been loyal to King George. As Theas attraction deepens into love, she learns to trust James and when he tells her that he is no longer a Jacobite and that he will never rise in rebellion again, she believes him. Their marriage fulfills the terms of James pardon, but when an English soldier kills a MacLonan clanswoman and the Jacobite leader, Bonnie Prince Charlie, is rumored to be in Scotland, will James abandon his promise to Thea and follow the Pretender in rebellion again? Or is he the victim of political games he cannot control?
