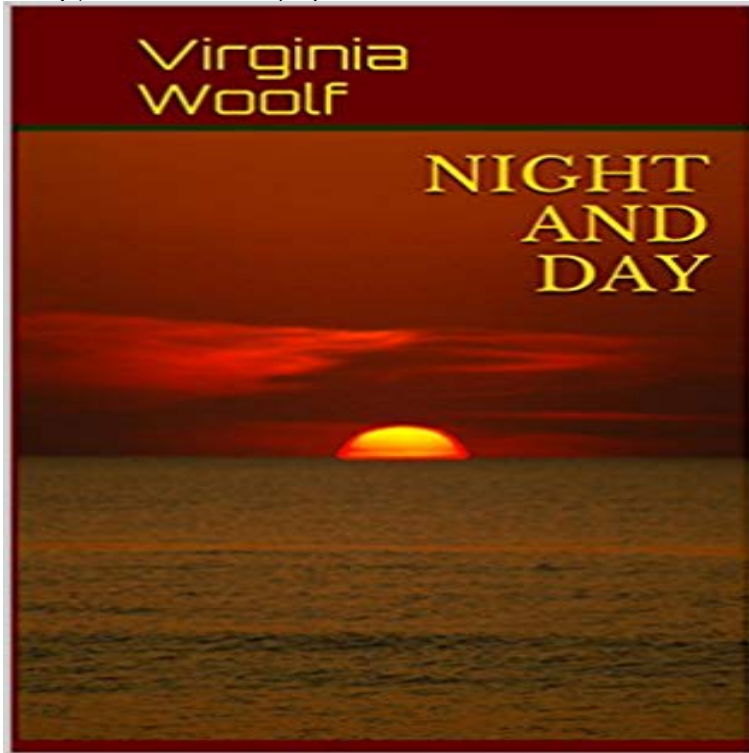


## Night and Day (Modernist Classics Book 3)

Her best-known works include: *Mrs Dalloway* (1925), *To the Lighthouse* (1927) and *Orlando* (1928), and *A Room of One's Own* (1929).
