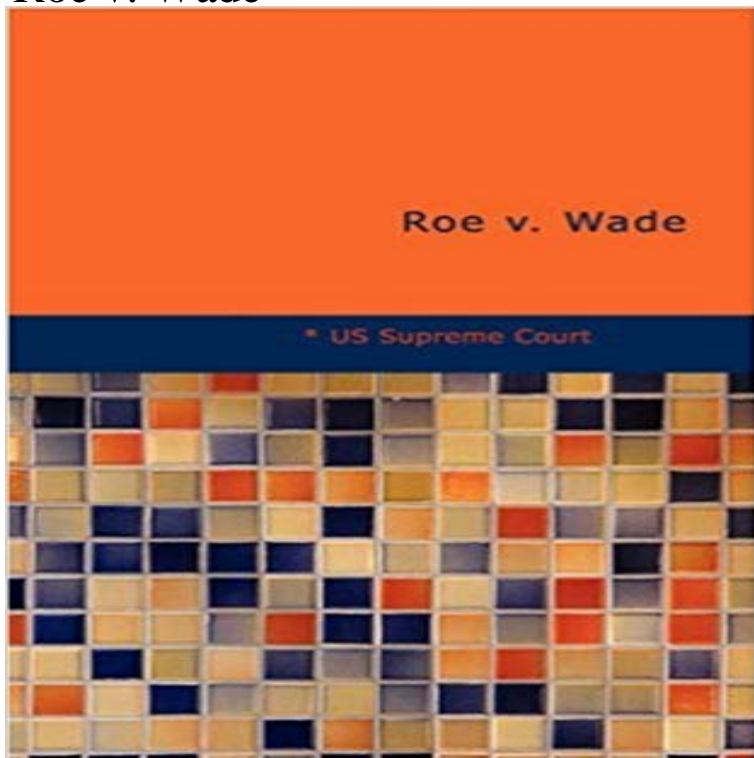


## Roe v. Wade
