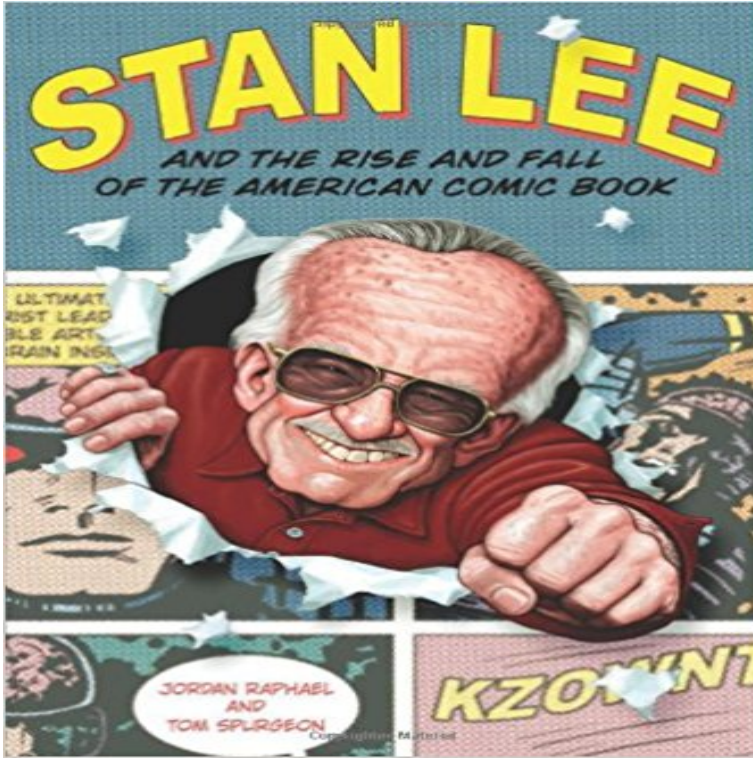


Stan Lee and the Rise and Fall of the American Comic Book
