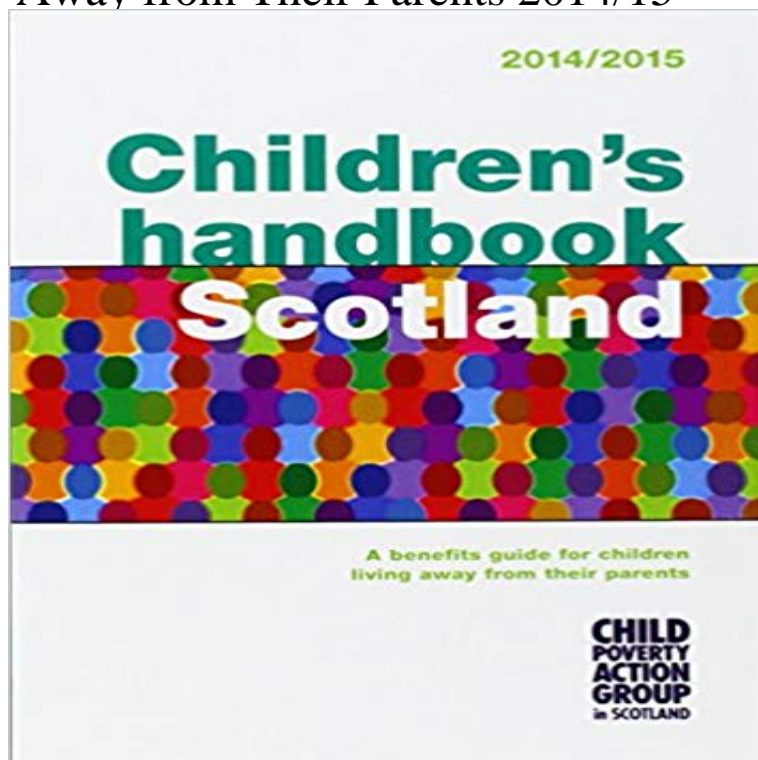


Childrens Handbook Scotland: A Benefits Guide for Children Living Away from Their Parents 2014/15
