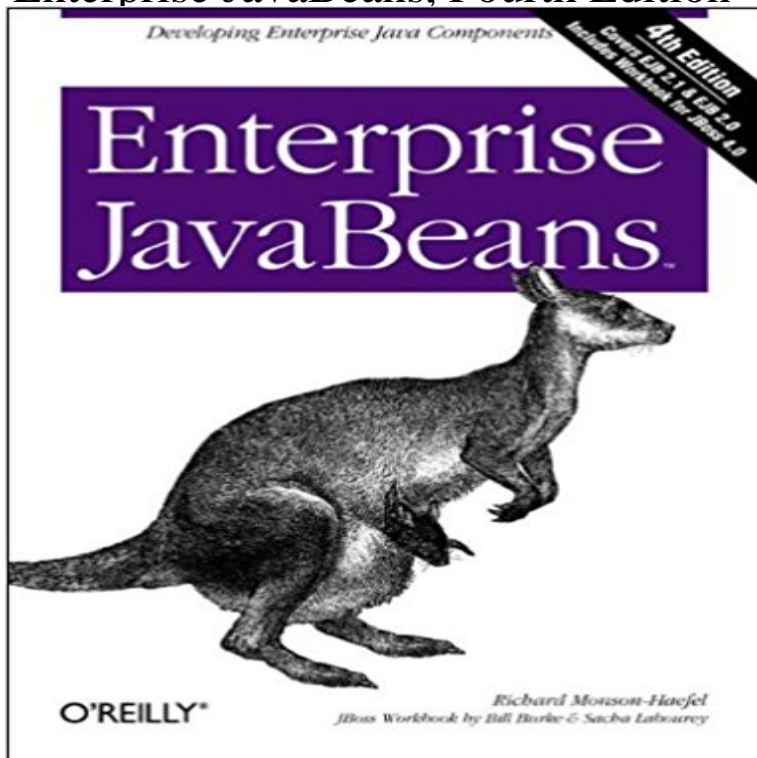


Enterprise JavaBeans, Fourth Edition
