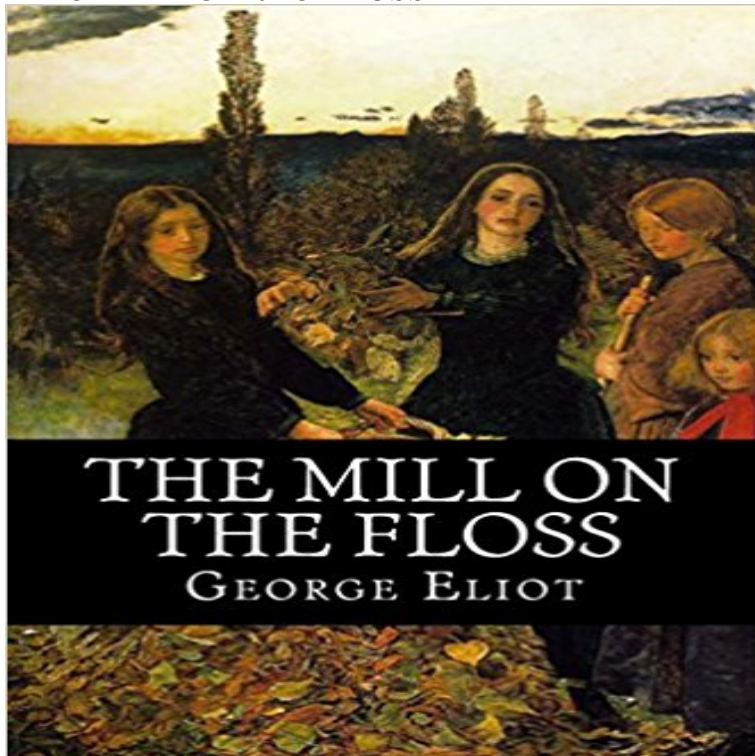


## The Mill on the Floss
