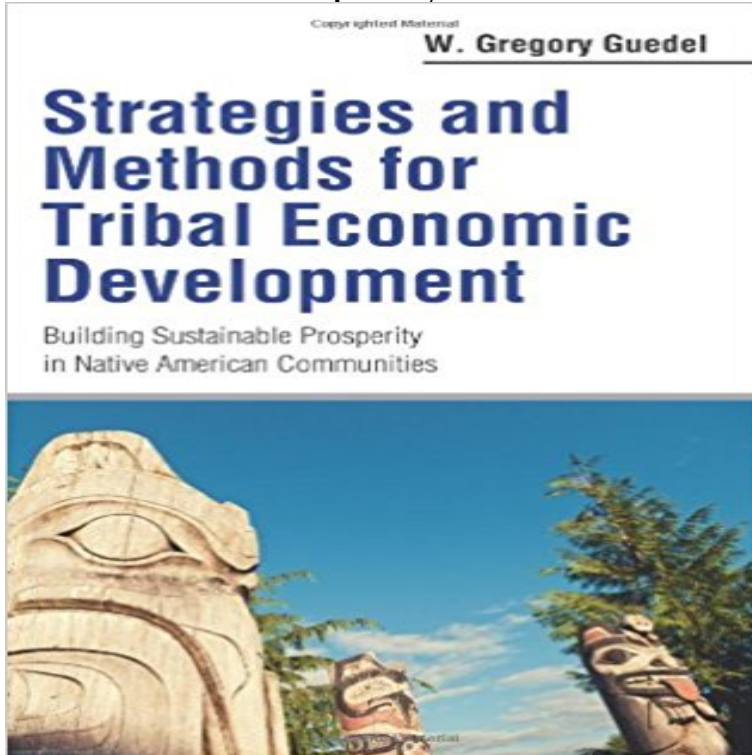


# Strategies and Methods for Tribal Economic Development: Building Sustainable Prosperity in Native American Communities
