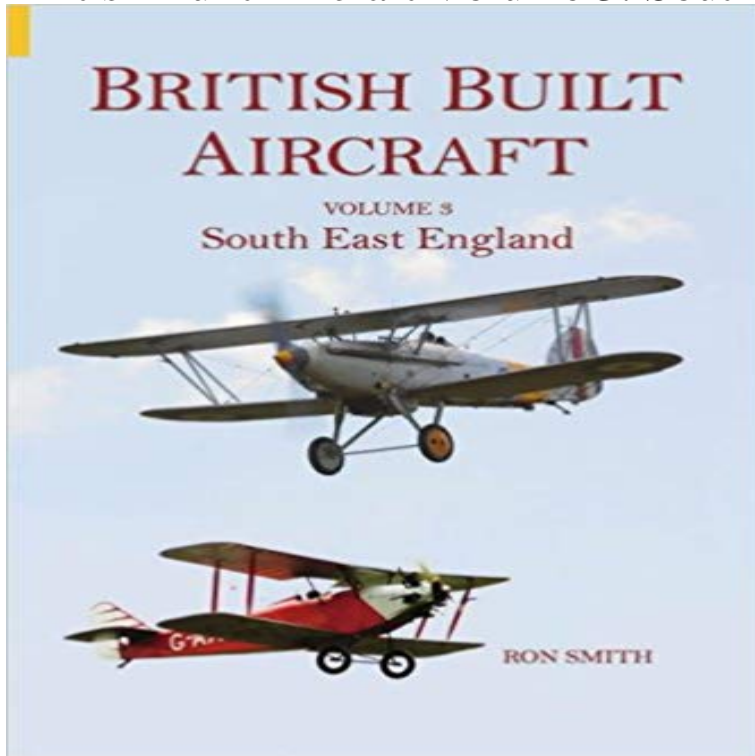


British Built Aircraft Volume 3: South East England
